Where does Dua Lipa live?

Dua Lipa is based in London, where she launched¹ her music career.

Where is Dua Lipa from?

Dua Lipa was born in London on 22 August 1995 to Kosovan-Albanian parents. She spent her early childhood in the city before moving to Kosovo, eventually returning to London as a teenager to pursue² music.

Who writes Dua Lipa's songs?

Dua Lipa collaborates with top-tier³ songwriters and producers. She co-writes many of her hits, including "Levitating" and "New Rules".

When did Dua Lipa get famous?

She reached global superstardom with *Future Nostalgia* in 2020, winning multiple Grammy Awards and BRIT Awards.

Her 2025 Wembley Stadium concert marked another major milestone in her career, proving her status as one of the world's leading pop artists.

From The Beatles, Oasis and Corinne Bailey Rae to, more recently, Youth Music Awards winner English Teacher, many of Britain's most-loved bands and artists originate from the North. The region emerged as a musical powerhouse for one important reason: in northern cities with strong industrial backgrounds, like Liverpool, Manchester and Sheffield, music became a form of expression and escape.

Oasis is a famous English rock band. They formed in Manchester, England, in 1991. The first members were Liam Gallagher (singer), Paul "Bonehead" Arthurs (guitar), Paul "Guigsy" McGuigan (bass), and Tony McCarroll (drums). A few months later, Liam asked his older brother Noel Gallagher (lead guitar, vocals) to join. Noel became the main leader and songwriter for their first four albums. Oasis is known as one of the most important and successful bands of the Britpop music style.

Oasis signed with Creation Records in 1993. Their first album, *Definitely Maybe* (1994), was a huge¹ hit. It quickly became the fastest-selling debut album in British history. The next year, they released² *(What's the Story) Morning Glory?* (1995).

BEATLES WALKING TOUR

Everything you need to know about the Beatles tour: practical details

- **When:** Thursdays and Sundays at 2.30pm
- **Starting point:** Meet your guide outside the Beatles Store, 231 Baker Street
- **End location:** Abbey Road crossing and studios, located near St John's Wood
- **Duration:** two hours and 30 minutes
- **Good to know:** Bring an Oyster card or contactless payment – the tour includes a short tube journey to Abbey Road.

What is the Beatles London walking tour and what to expect?

Before setting off, we get a quick overview of the route: from Marylebone to St John's Wood, stopping at spots tied to¹ The Beatles' legacy – from former and current homes to places where legendary songs like "Help!" and "Eleanor Rigby" were crafted². Highlights include glimpses³ of Paul's current London home and, of course, the Abbey Road Studios and its famous crossing.
